Low-income Board Member Elections – 2011

September 30, 2011

There are four (4) Project BRAVO Board of Directors Low-income Representative positions that are up for public election during 2011:

1. Upper Valley/West (currently held by Mago Arellano)
2. Northeast (currently held by Felix Valenzuela)
3. Southside (currently held by Arturo Moreno)
4. Lower Valley (currently held by Nina Serna)

Project BRAVO will begin accepting nominations for these positions starting on Saturday, October 1, 2011. **The deadline to submit nomination forms to Project BRAVO will be Tuesday, October 20, 2011.** Neighborhood Improvement Associations (NIAs), Policy Advisory Committees (PACs) and the public in general may submit nominations for persons who wish to serve on the Project BRAVO Board of Directors as Low-income Representatives.

- Nominees must live in the district they are running in but do not need to be low-income themselves.
- Persons may self-nominate.
- Each nominee must be approved by the Board of Directors. Approval of nominees will take place during the October 25 board of directors meeting.
- Public elections for these positions will take place during the period between November 1, 2011 and November 29, 2011.
- The exact date and location of each election will be determined by members of the Policy Advisory Committees (PACs) and Neighborhood Improvement Associations (NIAs) in each geographic area.
- Newly elected low-income board members will be sworn-in during the November 29th board meeting.
