For the 25<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, hundreds of community-minded El Pasoans will join together with Project BRAVO, Inc., to help elderly and disabled residents of our community beautify their homes.

This year's event is scheduled for **Saturday, September 17, 2011** from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Volunteer teams from the Government Employees Credit Union, Home Depot, the El Paso County Attorney's office, U.S. Customs and Border Patrol, Lions Clubs, Delphi, Western Hills United Methodist Church, Federal Managers Association, El Paso Young Democrats and numerous high school volunteer teams will be spending their Saturday morning painting homes throughout El Paso County.

This year's featured homes are located at 291 Limonite and 295 Limonite (near N. Mesa & Doniphan).

Since 1986, the homes of 1,774 elderly and disabled residents have been painted by more than 7,500 volunteers. *Helping people, changing lives.*
